NEWS FROM YOUR GENERAL MANAGER!

Now we just need Mother Nature to cooperate.

Every year for the last few years I have been able to say that almost our entire crew is back again and this year is no different. We are adding one new face, Jen Germann. She has already worked a couple of shifts and I think will be a great addition to our staff. For all the staff that returns year after year it tells me they have a great work environment and that says a lot about how great the membership is at Edelweiss. You make it fun for people to work here and I appreciate that.

There have been a few changes over the winter that you should know about. One change inside the clubhouse and one on the golf course. Standing tee times will begin the week of Memorial Day. If you do not remember your standing tee time or want to change your time, please let us know. Standing tee times are a privilege that you have as a member: It is not a right. Please keep in mind that each tee time has a potential value of \$206 so each tee time that goes unfilled is lost revenue. Please do your part and call us at least 24 hours prior to your tee time to cancel. As has been the rule in the past, if you are a no show for your standing tee time 3 times in one season you will lose your privilege to have a standing tee time. Thank you for your understanding of this rule.

HAPPENINGS FROM THE BOARD

December 7, 2013

Annual Meeting of the Membership

There were 68 members present for the annual meeting with a total of 51 certificates represented.

The terms of directors Tim Abraham, Steve Sailing, and Dennis Thoman expire this year. Steve declined to run for the board for another term. Gary Steiner was nominated to replace Steve on the board with Tim and Dennis serving another term.

Don Benning, the accountant from the firm of Benning Group, LLC of Monroe spoke to the membership regarding the financial condition of Edelweiss. Last year was an exceptionally good year for Edelweiss.

President Pete Eddington thanked Michael Durst who has been doing our monthly financial reports for the past seven years. He introduced Larry Price who has volunteered to help Pat with preparing the monthly financial reports.

Pete told the membership that we have renewed our loan with the Bank of New Glarus for 10 years. The entire mortgage will be paid off in the 10 year life of the note.

Dick Hartman, Membership Chairman, reviewed the changes in the membership at Edelweiss for the past year. We lost 22 members and gained 22 new members. At the end of the season we had 225 certificate holding members.

December 7, 2013

The purpose of this meeting was to elect officers for the 2014 season and set the date of the next board meeting.

Pete Eddington, President, Dick Hartman, Secretary, and Richard Arn, Treasurer will all keep their offices for a second year. Tim Abraham was elected Vice President.

January 18, 2014

Pete Eddington gave the board members the committee assignments for the 2014 season. Most of the work of the board is done in committees and then committee recommendations are presented to the entire board for approval.

Most of the outings that we had last year are coming back again with the exception of Certco. They are going to a larger golf course for their annual outing.

A tree drive will be started at the Super Bowl party so that more trees can be planted on the course next fall.

February 18, 2014

Jeff will be sending a mass email to members reminding them that they can earn \$100 in edelcash if they refer a new member to Edelweiss.

The First Tee program that Edelweiss participates in will furnish golf equipment to the school to encourage interest in golfing. The cost is \$3600 but Jeff will seek donations or do fund raisers to cover the cost.
